These are good quality flash cards. I have to address the issue that this is not a complete set. This is a complete set but they don't include repetitive sums giving the impression at first glance it's not complete but in fact is. For example 1x4 is the same as 4x1 so they only include 4x1 card assuming

the child is being taught they are interchangeable.

Does NOT contain all combinations of multiplication table. Might be OK for review, NOT for teaching.

Would not recommend this. Cards are not in any order and do not have all 1 through 12 times table cards.

These were a FRUSTRATING buy! We had to buy two sets for my 4th grader's class, and one of them came opened. Then, she said that, although she was supposed to have 108 cards (2 decks x 54 cards = 108 MULTIPLICATION!), but only had 106. (Each deck has one "instructions" card, I don't know if they're counting that in the total set of what the back of the box calls "54 fun-filled flash cards." So I set out to figure out which one (or ones) we were missing. There are 53 cards, each one double-sided, meaning a total of 106 problems are represented out of a total of 169 that OUGHT to be there (since 53 cards x 2 problems per card = 106, but 0-12 is 13 different digits, multiplied each by each other, for a 13x13 set - you get me, right) So I printed out a math table and started crossing them off. Some pairs are double represented (e.g., both 3x5 and 5x3 are included. Others have NO pair represented (namely, either version of: 6x0, 9x1, 3x10, 9x11, or 6x12). That seems a pretty glaring oversight! The first three are easy enough, but I bet you're struggling to do 6x12 in your head right now, right? Now imagine you're in 4th grade! The plus side: the cards are nice and big, and the solutions in the top left corner are easy to read for drills, but not obtrusive to the child looking at the card. Decent size, rounded edges, etc. That said, I simply CANNOT recommend these cards as they are (and we got two decks, so our experience seems to be rather wide spread!)

doing lumosity on a regular basis made me realize how important math is. We have a tendency to get lazy in this computer age. I use these to help my granddaughter with memorization of the times tables. Each one she gets right she gets to keep that card, and we go all the way through and the ones that are missed get the repeat. They are sturdy, and bright and easy to see.

Kids loved this. My 9-year Grandson was having trouble with some of his division tables, and multiplication is the reverse. SO I bought both sets for him, and both he and his 7-year old sister have been enjoying them. It's a fun way to learn and reinforce. Now my Grandson doesn't need them, but he helps his younger sister "play" the game! These are large, easy to read and see and

the kids really like them.

Great cards - Happy to use these for my 3rd grader's multiplication facts since common core seems to believe that we do not need to teach our kids multiplication tables anymore. Whether you're a carpenter, physicist or physician, it's still imperative to have instant recall with your multiplication tables rather than as yourself why $7 \times 7 = 49$;) 5 stars since all the answers were correct - Tough to rate them any less!

Hate these cards. They reduced the number of cards by putting a problem on each side of the card (therefore 2 per card) with the answers in small print. This doesn't seem too bad until you want to just have your daughter practice the 7 times tables, There is no way to do it since some of the ones I want are on both sides of a card! For example 0×7 is on the back of 7×4 . Anyways, I am going to look for a set with one problem on one side, and one answer on the other side. Note, cards are study if you like this format.
