

Cat lovers will treasure this book! The New Yorkerâ™s staff has created a second volume of cat cartoons by adding more recent cat cartoons since the first book came out as well as some older cartoons. As before, the 86 pages bristle with humor about our relationships to cats, a catâ™s eye on our world, and the usual switching of cats and people into each otherâ™s roles. To my taste, over half of the cartoons were outstanding, and all were good. Here are some of my favorites. Man visiting bare-chested yogi on a ledge outside a cave entrance is surrounded by cats. "The meaning of life is cats." Sam Gross; Wall of books with signs about them "Travel, Science, History, Fiction, Cute Cats."
