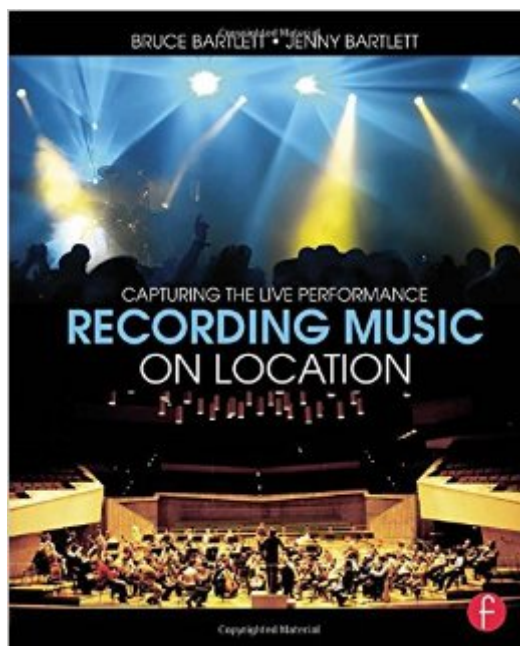

Unlike many people who are in bands, no one in the group is interested in going "Pro" because 1) they love their day jobs, and 2) they want to keep the FUN! in their music by not feeling forced to chase the almighty dollar. But, that

doesn't mean that they don't want to record their music to share their passion with friends and also for their own enjoyment, when they aren't jamming together. This book is WONDERFUL in its comprehensive tutorial on just how to professionally capture that ephemeral sound! The book is broken down into Part I: Popular Music Recording (Rock, Country, Jazz, Folk, R & B, Gospel, Christian, and so on) and Part II: Classical Music Recording (Orchestra, String Quartet, Pipe Organ, Choir, and Soloist). Chapter headings for Part I include: 1) Gear for live recordings; 2) Recording techniques from simple to complex; 3) Before the session: Planning; 4) At the session: set up and recording; 5) After the session: mixing and editing; 6) A real-world example: Recording a Blues Band in a Club; and 7) Web audio and Streaming. Chapter headings for Part II include: 8) Microphone sessions; 9) Overview of Stereo Microphone Techniques; 10) Stereo Recording Procedures; 11) Troubleshooting Stereo Sound; 12) Stereo, Surround, and Binaural Microphones and Accessories. A) Stereo Imaging Theory; B) Specific Free-Field Stereo Microphone Techniques; C) Stereo Boundary-Microphone Arrays; D) Binaural Techniques; and E) Surround-Sound Miking Techniques. There is both a Glossary of Terms and Index at the very end of the book.

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
